## MATERIALS

- ▶ 4 Ply High Bulk Acrylic Yarn in **White (or your preferred main color), Brown (or your preferred contrasting color) and Blue (or your preferred scrubs color)**
- ▶ crochet hook G
- ▶ tapestry needle
- ▶ stitch markers - to mark the start of every row!
- ▶ lots and lots of pins to help you put all the pieces in place
- ▶ fiberfill stuffing
- ▶ safety eyes - i used 12mm. you can make use of a slightly smaller/bigger one as well. it all depends on your creativity and preference

## ABBREVIATIONS

- ▶ Ch - chain
- ▶ Sc - single crochet
- ▶ Hdc - half double crochet
- ▶ St/s - stitch
- ▶ BLO - back loops only

## PATTERN

### Face Mask - Make 1 using WHITE

For the face mask, make sure to start the ch 1 1/2 inches from the end of your yarn

Row 1: Ch 7, sc in 2nd ch from hook until the end, ch 1, turn (6)

Row 2: sc in each st across (6), ch 1, turn

Row 3: sc in each st across (6)

Fasten off leaving a 3 inch tail

### Eye Spot - Make 1 using BROWN

create a magic ring

Rnd 1: make 6 sc inside the magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: inc 2 times, 2hdc in each of the next 2 sts, inc in each of the remaining 2 sts [12]

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing

### **Nose - Make 1 using BROWN**

create a magic ring

Rnd 1: make 4 sc inside the magic ring [4]

Rnd 2: inc 4 times [8]

Rnd 3: [sc in each of the next 2 sts, dec] 2 times [6]

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing

### **Head - Make 1 using WHITE**

create a magic ring

Rnd 1: make 4 sc inside the magic ring [4]

Rnd 2: inc 4 times [8]

Rnd 3: [sc in next st, inc in st after] 4 times [12]

Rnd 4: [sc in each of the next 2 st, inc in st after] 4 times [16]

Rnd 5: sc all around [16]

Rnd 6: sc in each of the next 4 sts, inc 8 times, sc in each of the remaining 4 sts [24]

Rnd 7: sc in each of the next 4 sts, [sc in next st, inc in st after] 8 times, sc in each of the remaining 4 sts [32]

Rnd 8: sc in each of the next 6 sts, [sc in each of the next 3 sts, inc in st after] 4 times, sc in each of the remaining 10 sts [36]

Rnd 9: sc in each of the next 6 sts, [sc in each of the next 4 sts, inc in st after] 4 times, sc in each of the remaining 10 sts [40]

Rnd 10-16: sc all around [40]



1. Sew on the nose to the tip of rounds 1 to 3 as seen in the photo to the side. You may opt to stuff the nose, but I didn't
2. Below the nose, sew a little smile
3. For the right eye, place a safety eye in the middle of the eye patch and sew it between Rnds 5-12.
4. Place the left safety eye in between rnds 6-7, 1 finger from where you sewed the nose

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Rnd 17: [sc in each of the next 8 sts, dec] 4 times [36]

Rnd 18: [sc in each of the next 4 sts, dec] 6 times [30]

Rnd 19: [sc in each of the next 3 sts, dec] 6 times [24]

Rnd 20: [sc in each of the next 2 sts, dec] 6 times [18]

Rnd 21: [sc in next st, dec] 6 times [12]

Rnd 22: [sc in next st, dec] 4 times [8]  
Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

### **Ears - make 2 using BROWN**

create a magic ring

Rnd 1: make 5 sc inside the magic ring [5]

Rnd 2: inc 5 times [10]

Rnd 3: [sc in next st, inc in st after] 5 times [15]

Rnd 4: [sc in each of the next 2 st, inc in st after] 5 times [20]

Rnd 5-6: sc all around [20]

Rnd 7: [sc in each of the next 2 st, dec] 5 times [15]

Rnd 8-9: sc all around [15]

Rnd 10: [sc in next st, dec] 5 times [10]

Rnd 11-15: sc all around [10]

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing

### **Surgeon's Cap - Make 1 using BLUE**

create a magic ring

Rnd 1: make 8 sc inside the magic ring [8]

Rnd 2: inc 8 times [16]

Rnd 3: [sc in next st, inc in st after] 8 times [24]

Rnd 4: [sc in each of the next 2 st, inc in st after] 8 times [32]

Rnd 5: [sc in each of the next 3 st, inc in st after] 8 times [40]

Rnd 6-11: sc all around [40]

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing

### **Legs - Make 2 using WHITE**

create a magic ring

Rnd 1: make 6 sc inside the magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: inc 6 times [12]

Rnd 3: [sc in next st, inc in st after] 6 times [18]

Rnd 4: through BLO, sc all around [18]

*Switch to BLUE*

Rnd 5-7: sc all around [18]

Rnd 8: [sc in next st, dec] 6 times [12]

Rnd 9: [sc in each of the next 3 sts, inc] 3 times [15]

Rnd 10-11: sc all around [15]

Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing

### **Legs - Make 2 using WHITE**

create a magic ring

Rnd 1: make 4 sc inside the magic ring [4]  
Rnd 2: inc 4 times [8]  
Rnd 3: [sc in next st, inc in st after] 4 times [12]  
Rnd 4: sc all around [12]  
Rnd 5: [sc in next st, dec] 4 times [8]  
Rnd 6-9: sc all around [8]  
*Switch to BLUE*  
Rnd 10-11: sc all around [8]  
Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing

### **Body - Make 1 using BLUE**

Rnd 1: Ch 7, sc in 2nd st from hook until last st, turn and sc in each of the 6 sts in the foundation ch [12]  
Rnd 2: inc 12 times [24]  
Rnd 3: [sc in each of the next 3 st, inc in st after] 6 times [30]  
Rnd 4: through BLO, sc all around [30]  
Rnd 5: sc all around [30]

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*Edging for the shirt:*

*Through the Front Loops of Round 3, sc all around [30]*

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Rnd 6: [sc in each of the next 3 st, dec] 6 times [24]  
Rnd 7-8: sc all around [24]  
Rnd 9: [sc in each of the next 2 st, dec] 6 times [18]  
Rnd 10-11: sc all around [18]  
*Switch to WHITE*  
Rnd 12: sc all around [18]  
Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing

## **ASSEMBLY**

1. Sew the ears to the surgeon's cap. I sewed it to the 3rd to the last round. You can make it higher or lower.





2. Firmly stuff the following: head, body, legs
3. Lightly stuff the arms
4. Sew the legs to the body. Make sure to sew it inside the edging of the shirt – basically, you're sewing the legs between rounds 1-3
5. Sew on the arms to each side of the body like so:



6. Sew on the head to the body



7. Sew on the cap to the head.
8. For the face mask, cut 5 inches of your white yarn and tie it to the edge of the mask without a tail. For the shorter of the ends of the tie, weave it through the edges until you're at the other end. See diagrams below.



9. Using the longer tail ends (the 3 inch ones), tie the face mask to the neck of your dog-tor making a ribbon.
